NOTE: This is an in-person meeting in the Beverly Public Library Sohler Room on the ground floor. After entering through the Winter Street doors, the Sohler Room is the first room on the left past the staircase.

The Beverly Recreation Department is applying for a state grant through the Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs Department of Conservation & Recreation. The grant is a \$400,000 Parkland Acquisitions and Renovations for Communities (PARC) Grant. We will also be applying for funding from the Beverly Community Preservation Committee and the David S. Lynch Trustees. This project is estimated to cost about \$750,000 and is designed to replace or renovate 3 of the worst tennis courts and 4 of the worst basketball courts in Beverly. The list of courts will be part of this project include:

Holcroft Park – 40 Mill Street – Replace basketball court
Gilbert Park/Bartlett Gardens – 36R Stone Street – Renovate basketball court
Carateau Park – 154 Park Street – Renovate basketball court
Hellard-Hubis Park – 50 McKay Street – Renovate basketball court
Kimball-Haskell Park – 225 Lothrop Street – Replace 2 tennis courts
Cahill Park – 9 Hull Street – Replace tennis court
