1. Access through the Google Meet application. This application will allow users to view the meeting and request comment using the Chat function or speaking through the computer microphone. Pursuant to Open Meeting Law, M.G.L. c. 30A, §20, the Chair may elect to recognize public comment submitted through the Chat function at appropriate points in the meeting.

The listing of the foregoing matters are those reasonably anticipated by the Chair up to 48 hours prior to the scheduled meeting time. It is possible that not all items listed on the agenda will be discussed or reached. Matters may be discussed that arise within 48 hours of the scheduled meeting if they were not reasonably anticipated by the Chair.

 - ii. For mobile devices (tablets and iPhones/smartphones):

 2. Allow the program to access your device's camera and microphone.
 3. Then click 'Enter a meeting code' and type in 'dpr-fmow-mty'. Then click 'Ask to join.'
