1. Access through the Google Hangouts Meet application. This application will allow users to view the meeting and request comment using the Chat function. **Pursuant to Open Meeting Law, M.G.L. c. 30A, §20, the Chair may elect to recognize public comment at appropriate points in the meeting.** If any member of the public would like to submit a comment prior to the meeting, or would like to make it known prior to the meeting that he/she would like to comment on any item on the agenda, individuals should submit comments or requests to Associate Planner Victoria Healey at vhealey@beverlyma.gov
 - a. **Google Hangouts Meet meeting login instructions:**
 - i. For computers, browse to the following web address: meet.google.com/awb-xvwv-wxf
 - ii. For mobile devices (tablets and iPhones/smartphones):
 1. Please go to either 'Google Play' [Android] or the iOS 'App Store' [iPhones and iPads] and download the free program 'Google Meet'.
 2. Allow the program to access your device's camera and microphone.
 3. Then click 'Enter a meeting code' and type in 'awb-xvwv-wxf.' Then click 'Ask to join.' A facilitator will enable you to enter the meeting.
 - b. **Telephone: For standard telephones and cell phones:**
